



HEALTH INFORMATION ACT

DESIGNATED ELECTRONIC HEALTH INFORMATION SYSTEMS

The electronic health information systems in this document are designated for the purpose of section 63 of the *Health Information Act*. These systems hold personal health information for delivery of, evaluation of, monitoring of, or payment for health services, or creation and maintenance of an electronic record containing personal health information. These systems are typically the primary chart for the program or service area.

Name of System	Description of System
BDM Pharmacy	The in-patient pharmacy information system used by Northwest Territories Health and Social Services Authority (NTHSSA) at Stanton Territorial Hospital, Inuvik Regional Hospital; and Hay River Health and Social Services Authority (HRHSSA) at Hay River Regional Health Center.
Enterprise Imaging	The system used for storing and accessing medical imaging, consolidating patient imaging records into one record, and enabling access to imaging studies from anywhere in the NWT. Updated Xero Viewer is a viewing tool used to view medical images in Enterprise Imaging.
Electronic Medical Record System (EMR)	The system used in all health and social services' authorities for scheduling, longitudinal charting, and billing to support the delivery of individual care.
Enterprise Master Patient Index (EMPI)	The repository for all NWT residents' demographic information received from feeder systems (other NWT electronic health information systems, such as EMR, iEHR).
Health Management Information System (HMIS)	The system used to adjudicate physician and hospital claims, provide case and invoice management for medical travel, and maintain NWT Health Care Plan and Extended Health Benefits eligibility information. HMIS is comprised of these components: • Medigent software: ○ Healthcare Registration ○ Extended Health Benefits ○ Provider Tracking

Health Suite	The system used for service event tracking for home care visits in NTHSSA - Yellowknife Region and service event tracking at the Department of Health and Social Services.
Continuing Care Information System	The assessment instrument for Home Care, Long Term Care, and Extended Care to inform clinical needs and service planning. The e-system is used also for home care activity tracking.
Interoperable Electronic Health Record (iEHR)	The system brings together information from some designated e-systems into one location where the information can be viewed as one record. The designated e-systems sources are LIS, Enterprise Imaging, Medipatient, EMPI. The system provides “view” only, and the information resides in the sources systems.
Interoperable Public Health Information System (IPHIS)	The Public Health system used for communicable disease (such as tuberculosis) and sexually transmitted infection surveillance including contact tracing.
Laboratory Information System (LIS)	The system used to record information related to laboratory services.
MediPatient	The local hospital patient information system used by the NTHSSA and the Hay River Health and Social Services Authority (HRHSSA). It includes admission/discharge, radiology, rehabilitation, and scheduling functions.
RL6	The system used for incident reporting in the NWT by all health and social services authorities.
System for Accountability and Management (SAM)	The financial system used by the Government of the NWT for all health and medical billing.

Name of System	Description of System
Virtuo MIS (previously known as ORMED)	The billing system used with medical travel and integrated with HMIS. HRHSSA uses this system for Finance, Purchasing, Human Resources and Payroll.

COVID Self-Isolation Plan Registry and COVID Order Compliance Registry	On-demand software for the purposes of coordinating and providing for the delivery of essential public health services in the Northwest Territories, particularly as it relates to the triaging and tracking of COVID-19 self-isolation requirements of NWT residents, and employers and their employees, as identified in Public Health Orders. Diagnostic Imaging / Picture Archiving and Communication System (DI/PACS)	A system for the digitization, reading and analysis of diagnostic images and archiving for longitudinal use. Digital archiving systems known as Picture Archiving and Communications Systems (PACS) consist of groups of computer servers and special display computer stations that allow the viewing and archiving of digital/electronic images taken using diagnostic imaging, such as • X-ray • Magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) • CAT scan • CT scan Impax Viewer and Xero Viewer are viewing tools used to view information in DIPACS. MediPharm	The pharmacy management system used by the Hay River Health and Social Services Authority in Hay River.	October 1, 2015	November 2025
